A 60 mile ride in the Sussex Weald

To celebrate the Club's Diamond Jubilee

You are invited to take part in this ride which takes place on Tuesday **13 September 2011** starting from Southwater Country Park (near Horsham). Ample free parking.

The route follows a clockwise circuit, between the Forest Ridge and the South Downs. It is entirely on map OS 198. There is no entry fee, but prior entry (form overleaf, or from website) is essential. Entry by email acceptable.

Start between 9.15am and 10.15am. It is hoped that the café in the Country Park will be open (especially for us!). This depends on numbers. A secondary start at Cuckfield, between 11.00 am and 11.45 am, will be arranged for those arriving by train (at nearby Haywards Heath station) and who need to avoid restrictions on travel with a bike through London.

For those requiring a shorter ride, there is an option to return to Southwater using the Downs Link bridleway (off road, former railway line) directly from Bramber. This gives a ride of 45 miles.

Route sheet and route map will be supplied.

Suggested *elevenses*: Cuckfield, *lunch*: Bramber, *tea*: Wiston or Barns Green,(or back at Southwater for the shorter ride).

Participants should expect to encounter a few hills.
